## Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform youthat in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Ashtang Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, 2062, Sadashiv Peth, Survey No. 2032/B Vijayanagar Colony, Pune-411030, Maharashtra (Inst ID: AYU0142) inspection of your College was conducted on $15.05 .2023 \& 16.05 .2023$ on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 40 seats ( 50 Seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 09 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita \&Sanskrit \& Siddhanta-03 Seats (ii) Rachna Sharir-03 seats (iii) Prasuti \& Stri Roga-03 seats for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -
3. Central Library - There is shortcoming of 25 sitting capacity against the minimum requirement of 50 seats as per MSR 2016.
4. Teaching Pharmacy - Sitting arrangement is not adequate.
5. Functionality of the hospital -
a. Average Bed occupancy is $34.14 \%$, There is shortcoming of $15.86 \%$ against the minimum requirement of $50 \%$ as per MSR 2016.
b. Total no. of patients attended OPD from $1^{\text {st }}$ Jan 2022 to $31^{\text {st }} \operatorname{Dec} 2022$ is 32980, There is shortcoming of 3020 number of patients as per MSR 2016.
c. Average attendance of OPD per day is 109.3, shortcoming of 10.06 as per MSR 2016.
6. Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments availability is $71.63 \%$.
7. Transport facility is not available.
8. Observations by the visitor: -
a. There is no $X$ Ray Unit, USG Facility in the hospital.
